Has topped the leaderboard after five of the first nine rounds of the 2024 LIV Golf season ... Qualified for the 2024 Open Championship via his Australian Open win and received invitations to play in two other majors in 2024 – Masters and PGA Championship.

- HyFlyers GC Captain Phil Mickelson, who comes off • his best LIV Golf finish of his career (T7 in Jeddah), is among several players making their first competitive starts at Hong Kong Golf Club
- Wild Card player Anthony Kim makes his second start since joining LIV Golf last week following a nearly 12-year • retirement
- Majesticks GC Co-Captain Ian Poulter won the Hong Kong Open in 2010, while LIV Golf reserve player Wade Ormsby is a two-time champion and reserve player Ben Campbell is the defending champion

At the core of LIV Golf regular-season tournaments are the simultaneous individual and team competitions that create the sport's most unique competition. As the LIV Golf League heads into its second full year, adjustments have been made to enhance the drama and build on the world-class fields that compete across the globe.

HOW IT WORKS

TEAM

- Team standings for the regular season will determine the seeds for the season-ending Team Championship •
- The top four teams at the end of the regular season receive first-round byes
- Team points are awarded at each regular-season tournament to the top eight finishers

INDIVIDUAL

- Individual points earned throughout the season will be used to calculate the individual standings •
- The highest-ranked player following the Individual Championship event will be named the 2024 Individual Champion •
- The top three players at the end of the regular season will earn individual bonuses

LOCK ZONE

Players finishing in the top 24 at the end of the Individual Championship secure their 2025 spot in the LIV Golf League

OPEN ZONE


Players finishing 25-48 are open to potential trade, release or re-signing by their team

DROPZONE

Players finishing 49 and below are relegated out of the LIV Golf League and qualify for LIV Golf Promotions Note: 2024 Team Captains are exempt from relegation



PAR 70 YARDAGE 6,710

- Hong Kong Golf Club, established in 1889, has been a fixture in professional golf for more than six decades
- The club has hosted the Hong Kong Open since 1959 and is currently part of the 2024 Asian Tour schedule as one of the 10 International Series tournaments
- The Hong Kong Open is one of just three events in the history of golf to be played at the same venue for more than six decades
- Current LIV Golf League member Ian Poulter, co-captain of Majesticks GC, returns to the site of his Hong Kong Open win in 2010 in which he shot a career-best 10-under 60 in the second round
- A dozen current LIV Golf League members played in the most recent Hong Kong Open in 2023, including Ripper GC Captain Cameron Smith, who finished runner-up to current LIV Golf reserve player Ben Campbell
- LIV Golf Hong Kong will utilize the same composite layout at Fanling that is used by the Hong Kong Open
- The 493-yard ninth is the longest par-4 hole on the scorecard and generally considered the most difficult hole on the course

Shot 20-under in final round to win Jeddah, tying their League record for lowest team score in final round ... Only team with two podium results in 2024 ... One of five teams to finish with points in each of first three events in 2024 ... Puig enters Hong Kong with consecutive top-15 finishes ... Ancer's 12th-place finish in Jeddah was his best result of the season ... Ancer ranks second in League in Fairways Hit while Chacarra ranks fourth in Driving Distance.

Of 10 counting scores in Jeddah, just three were under par as team finished 12th overall ... Watson's second-round 66 was team's best score in Jeddah ... Uihlein has finished top 15 in each of three previous visits to Hong Kong Golf Club ... Wolff (sickness) coming off a secondround WD.

Team enters Hong Kong with two consecutive podium results (1-Las Vegas, 3-Jeddah) ... Team led Jeddah field in Greens in Regulation percentage ... Koepka has posted nine straight rounds in 60s to start season ... Kokrak's second-round 62 in Jeddah was his lowest score in 61 career LIV Golf rounds.

Team was one of just two teams to shoot in the 60s for all 10 counting rounds in Jeddah (Crushers the other team) ... Muñoz has nine consecutive rounds under par.

Poulter has previous success at Hong Kong Golf Club, having won the Hong Kong Open in 2010 ... Poulter leads League in Fairways Hit percentage ... Team led Jeddah field in Fairways Hit percentage ... Horsfield has played 179 consecutive holes without a 3-putt, the longest active streak in the League.

Smith led Jeddah field in Individual Putting Average and team led in Team Putting Average ... Herbert had team-high 17 birdies in Jeddah ... Jones has played 174 consecutive holes without a 3-putt, the second longest active streak in the League ... Smith finished solo second at 2023 Hong Kong Open.



5 Louis Oosthuizen[®] 13 Dean Burmester 18 Charl Schwartzel 32 Branden Grace

In Jeddah, Oosthuizen (T2) tied his best LIV Golf result and Schwartzel (T2) had his best result since winning 2022 London ... All four players finished inside top 15 ... Grace led field in both Fairways Hit and Greens in Regulation, Burmester led in Driving Distance, and Burmester (T1), Schwartzel (T1) and Oosthuizen (3) were top three in Scrambling.



Two Wild Cards players will compete at every LIV Golf tournament in 2024, bringing the field size to 54 players.

Wild cards will not be attached to a team, but they can win prize money and accumulate points toward the season-long Individual Championship race.

Anthony Kim and Hudson Swafford are the Wild Cards for Hong Kong.

LOWEST ROUNDS IN LIV GOLF HISTORY


