KEY STORYLINES

- The LIV Golf League visits Las Vegas for the first time; it's the 19th different global market and 11th different U.S. market to host a League or Promotions tournament
- The historic Las Vegas Country Club, established in 1967 and the city's longest-standing country club, is the host site
- Torque GC Captain Joaquin Niemann will seek his second consecutive victory after winning the season-opening LIV Golf Mayakoba on the fourth hole of a playoff against Fireballs GC Captain Sergio Garcia
- LIV Golf's first expansion team, Legion XIII captained by reigning Masters champion Jon Rahm and including Tyrrell Hatton, Caleb Surratt and Kieran Vincent, won its debut event at Mayakoba
- Surratt, the 19-year-old former University of Tennessee sophomore who turned pro prior to Mayakoba, posted a final-round 67 and finished with five consecutive birdies
- Rahm tied for third on the individual leaderboard while his former Ryder Cup partner Hatton tied for eighth in their LIV Golf debuts
- Local resident Kevin Na, captain of Iron Heads GC, has won two professional events in Las Vegas and Crushers GC Captain Bryson DeChambeau has one win in the area
- Of the top 10 players in the Individual Championship standings, seven are team captains – Niemann, Garcia, Rahm, Dustin Johnson (4Aces GC), Brooks Koepka (Smash GC), Cameron Smith (Ripper GC) and Louis Oosthuizen (Stinger GC)

SUPER WEEK IN VEGAS

LIV Golf Las Vegas, which begins on Thursday and finishes on Saturday, will be played six miles away from Sunday's Super Bowl LVIII at Allegiant Stadium.

"It's going to be electric," Bryson DeChambeau said of this week at Las Vegas Country Club.

"I think it's going to be fantastic," added Dustin Johnson.

Said Phil Mickelson: "LIV Golf Las Vegas is an opportunity to showcase what LIV Golf can bring to the U.S. ... In the U.S., our demographic is much younger than the traditional golf fan. To be in Las Vegas the week of the Super Bowl, that's the demographic we're trying to hit."

At the core of LIV Golf regular-season tournaments are the simultaneous individual and team competitions that create the sport’s most unique competition. As the LIV Golf League heads into its second full year, adjustments have been made to enhance the drama and build on the world-class fields that compete across the globe.

HOW IT WORKS

TEAM

- Team standings for the regular season will determine the seeds for the season-ending Team Championship
- The top four teams at the end of the regular season receive first-round byes
- Team points are awarded at each regular-season tournament to the top eight finishers

INDIVIDUAL

- Individual points earned throughout the season will be used to calculate the individual standings
- The highest-ranked player following the Individual Championship event will be named the 2024 Individual Champion
- The top three players at the end of the regular season will earn individual bonuses

LOCK ZONE

Players finishing in the top 24 at the end of the Individual Championship secure their 2025 spot in the LIV Golf League

OPEN ZONE

Players finishing 25-48 are open to potential trade, release or re-signing by their team

DROP ZONE

Players finishing 49 and below are relegated out of the LIV Golf League and qualify for LIV Golf Promotions

- The historic Las Vegas Country Club becomes the 11th different course in the United States to host a LIV Golf tournament
- The course, which opened in 1967, was designed by Ed Ault and built on the site of a horse and automobile racetrack
- The club, which features a 54,000 square-foot clubhouse, was frequented by Las Vegas celebrities Elvis Presley, Frank Sinatra and Dean Martin
- LVCC has hosted multiple professional golf tournaments, including the Las Vegas Invitational from 1983-91
- Among the past winners is LIV Golf Commissioner & CEO Greg Norman, who won in 1986
- The 146-yard par-3 eighth will offer a party-hole atmosphere reminiscent of previous party holes in Adelaide and Chicago
- Course routing: The nines have been reversed from the member routing, with the member front nine playing as the back nine for LIV Golf Las Vegas
- The 469-yard 18th hole has been converted to a par-4 hole from the members' par 5
- Grass type: Rye grass/Bermudagrass on tees, fairways, first cut, rough and fringe/collar; Bent grass (Penn Link/T1) on greens
- Projected green speed: 12.5


